

SOH---Guidelines for Healing Prayer

Learn a model, but stay flexible.

- a. QRST
- b. Vineyard 5 Step
- c. Follow Biblical guidelines; oil & elders, etc.

Operate in Teams of two or three.

- a. Be sensitive to gender, age, and temperament considerations.

Allow the person seeking healing to be comfortable

- a. Do not lean on people.
- b. Do not lay hands on people inappropriately.
- c. Do not seek to evoke dramatic manifestations.
- d. Be sensitive to the setting.
- e. Know when to seek counsel from pastor.

Be a conduit or vessel, not a quasi-doctor.

- a. Never try to medically diagnose or advise someone to disregard their doctor's orders.

Pay attention to the Spirit and to the person for whom you are praying.

Don't feel you have to achieve immediate visible results.

Don't smother the person with words.

Don't allow your soul to get in the way of the Spirit.
